The Public Works Building Committee met in August and September to finalize securing an Owner's Project Manager for the project. A Request for Qualifications was posted and we received proposals from a number of qualified applicants. The PWBC was able to narrow the list of interviews to 3 and is on track to select an OPM to start the design process.

We were awarded the Assistance to Firefighters Grant (FG) Grant, in the amount of \$1,000,000 in federal funding for Norfolk & Wrentham to purchase a regional 100ft Aerial Tower Truck.






The updated Agenda Center allows for the storing, sharing, and searching of public meetings and agendas, enabling citizens to remain informed and engaged in public policy and local issues.
